2. Please provide a short statement explaining why you are interested in joining the CCAP panel and describing how you plan to incorporate appointed appellate work into your practice. For example, do you intend to gravitate toward doing appeals exclusively? Are you hoping to do more than one or two short appeals per year, maintaining your greatest emphasis on trial court litigation or civil practice? How many hours per week (on average) do you think you would like to devote to appointed appeals?
3. You must submit at least two writing samples that demonstrate your ability to research and present arguments on issues of law. Appellant's Opening Briefs are ideal, but if you have none, other persuasive writing is acceptable. Please include copies of the opposing briefs as well, if possible. CCAP places very heavy weight on the quality of the writing samples, so choose accordingly. Feel free to include any explanation that you believe will help CCAP evaluate the quality of your writing. If the writing bears the signature of another attorney but was written at least in part by you, explain which parts you wrote and the extent to which your portion was edited by another attorney. Your writing samples will NOT be returned to you, so send copies only.
4. If your request to join the panel is granted, you will be required to register on CCAP's web site: www.capcentral.org It is free, but is one of the major resources we have for alerting panel attorneys of important news (case law, policy changes, new procedures, etc.), and we will expect you to visit frequently. A current email address is also required for this purpose and will be kept confidential. You can sign up for periodic resource mailings (summaries of recent cases, announcements, breaking news, training, etc.)
